- **Full Disclosure.** Our Foundation engages in annual independent audit and full financial disclosure. We submit annual audited financial statements for publication in the minutes of the Georgia Baptist Convention each year.
- **Confidentiality.** We respect our client's confidentiality and do not release their names to any source without permission.
- **Integrity.** Our intent is to be truthful in all communications. There is never any intended omission, misrepresentation or exaggeration which might lead to unrealistic expectations.
